Join the StiMZu Project: Strengthening Migrant Organizations for Climate Action

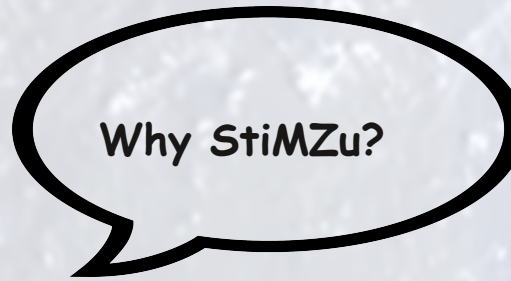

The main cause of climate change: fossil fuel combusting. In this photo: a coal power plant.

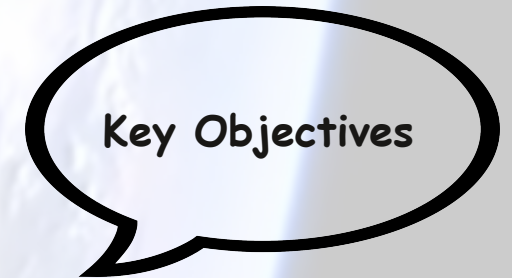


In Brandenburg, many newly established African initiatives and migrant organizations face significant challenges in participating in climate protection efforts. These challenges include a lack of awareness, limited resources, and insufficient collaboration with climate activists. The result is a low level of networking and idea exchange, hindering the ability of these organizations to contribute to climate action.

StiMZu addresses this gap by providing the necessary tools, knowledge, and resources to empower migrant organizations to take a proactive role in climate protection. Through our project, we aim to bridge the divide between migrant communities and climate activists, fostering a collaborative environment where everyone can contribute to sustainable solutions.

Collaboration and Partnership: Strengthen the partnerships between migrant organizations, climate activists, and other stakeholders. By fostering a collaborative network, we aim to enhance the effectiveness of climate action among migrant organisations in Brandenburg.

Motivation for Activism: Encourage and inspire migrant organizations to take active roles in climate protection. The StiMZu Project seeks to increase the motivation of participants to engage in local environmental protection measures, political advocacy, and participation in broader climate protection initiatives.

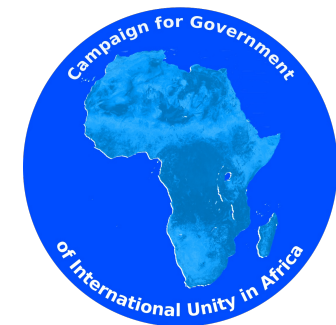
